They eventually made their way to Europe on trading ships in the 19th century and now these puzzles are enjoyed all over the world.








Paper Dolls Around the World: Asia IV Color me and dress me up!



When you see a flag card matching one below, say the name of the country and claim the flag. Maximum 4 people can play this game.









### **ORIGAMI BOAT RACE**

**Summary:** Teach children how to make an origami boat- and then race them.

Goal: See whose origami boats can reach the end the quickest.

# **Preparation:**


- Blank pieces of standard printer paper
- Straws (a straw per person)
- Large plastic tub filled with water
- Markers

## **How to Play the Origami Boat Race:**

- 1. Hand everyone a piece of paper. Teach everyone how to fold an origami boat (instructions are on the next page).
- 2. After everyone folds their paper boats, have them name and decorate their boats.
- 3. Have two volunteers to race their boats. Place both boats on one side of the tub. When you say "go", have them use the straw to blow their boats to the other side of the tub.
